## RULES, GUIDELINES AND DRESS CODE - MONARCH HIGH SCHOOL PROM 2009

---

### 1. TO PURCHASE YOUR TICKET(S), YOU MUST HAVE:

- **All obligations cleared.** Get a signature from Mrs. Rode (at lunch or before school) the week before Spring Break
- **\$100 cash for each ticket** (each student may purchase 2 tickets)
- **This permission slip** signed by parent and student for each student attending prom
- **A permission slip for your date if not a Monarch student** (signed by parent and student)
- **Your Monarch Senior photo ID and a copy of your date's photo ID**

2. If your date is not a student at Monarch High School, he/she **may not be older than 20 (twenty)** and he/she must also fill out these forms, have it signed by their parent and attach a photocopy of a government-issued ID (driver's license, Florida Identification card, or passport). **These things must be submitted at the time you purchase your tickets.**

3. **THERE ARE NO REFUNDS**...even if you get suspended, become ill, break up with your date, change your mind about going, or are asked to leave due to dress code violation at the dance, etc.

4. All sales **FINAL**. You may not give or sell your ticket to anyone else.

5. When you check in at the dance, **you must show your ticket and both you and your date's photo ID.** Once you check-in, you may not leave the area. **We will be using breathalyzers and will search each student/guest before they enter the prom. STUDENTS ARRIVING AFTER 8:00 WILL NOT BE ADMITTED.**

6. While at the dance, you and your date **MUST** adhere to the **Broward County School's code of Student Conduct – this includes the drug and weapons policy. There will be no tobacco products allowed at the prom (even by dates who do not attend Monarch High School).**

7. **Dress attire for the dance is formal.** No casual wear will be permitted. Boys should wear a suit, tuxedo, or dress pants/shirt and tie. Your shirt must have a collar. Girls should wear an appropriate long or cocktail length dress. If you are not sure if your attire is acceptable, please see Mrs. McMillan in Art Studio 442.

**IF YOU ARE NOT DRESSED APPROPRIATELY, YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED ENTRANCE TO THE PROM.**
