

MONARCH HS PROM PERMISSION SLIP 2010
RULES, GUIDELINES AND DRESS CODE

I authorize my child _____, to attend Monarch High School's Senior Prom, May 15, 2010, from 7:00 to 11:00 p.m. at the ***Ft. Lauderdale Airport Hilton Hotel.***

1. TO PURCHASE YOUR TICKET(S), YOU MUST HAVE:

- **All obligations cleared.** Get a signature from Mrs. Rode (at lunch or before school) the week before Spring Break
- **\$100 cash for each ticket** (each student may purchase 2 tickets)
- **This permission slip** signed by parent and student for each student attending prom
- **A permission slip for your date if not a Monarch student** (signed by parent and student)
- **Your Monarch Senior photo ID and a COPY of your date's photo ID if they don't attend MHS**

2. If your date is not a student at Monarch High School, he/she **may not be older than 20 (twenty)** and he/she must also fill out these forms, have it signed by their parent and attach a photocopy of a government-issued ID (driver's license, Florida Identification card, or passport). **These things must be submitted at the time you purchase your tickets.**

3. **THERE ARE NO REFUNDS...**even if you get suspended, become ill, break up with your date, change your mind about going, or are asked to leave due to dress code violation at the dance, etc.

4. All sales **FINAL**. You may not give or sell your ticket to anyone else.

5. When you check in at the dance, **you must show your ticket and both you and your date's photo ID.** We will be using breathalyzers and metal detectors and will search each student/guest before they enter the prom. **STUDENTS ARRIVING AFTER 8:00 WILL NOT BE ADMITTED.** Once you check-in, you may not leave the area.

6. While at the dance, you and your date **MUST** adhere to the **Broward County School's code of Student Conduct – this includes the drug/alcohol and weapons policy.** There will be no tobacco products/lighters allowed at the prom (even by dates who do not attend Monarch High School).

7. **Dress attire for the dance is formal.** No casual wear will be permitted. Boys should wear a suit, tuxedo, or dress pants/shirt and tie. Your shirt must have a collar. Girls should wear an **appropriate** long or cocktail length dress. If you are not sure if your attire is acceptable, please see Mrs. McMillan in Art Studio 442.

IF YOU ARE NOT DRESSED APPROPRIATELY, YOU WILL BE ASKED TO COVER UP OR YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED ENTRANCE TO THE PROM. Girls...we know your "hair trick" to hide low-cut dresses, so please don't risk it.
