

Grad Bash 2010 – Friday, April 30!!!

Rules and Dress Code:



Students going to Grad Bash will meet in the auditorium at 1:30pm



We will be returning to school at 6:30 AM on Saturday, May 1st. **Your ride must be on time picking you up!**



You must be in school ALL day on April 30th to go to Grad Bash... no signing in or out, no tardies, **NO EXCEPTIONS!**



It is best if you do not drive to school that day – Have someone drop you off so you do not have to leave your car unattended in the school lot overnight... Security will **NOT** be provided in the parking lot. You park at your own risk.



YOU MUST HAVE A PHOTO ID TO BOARD THE BUSES



Be aware that all personal articles are subject to inspection by SBBC staff. To ensure safety for all, local law enforcement will provide dogs as needed for discovery of any illegal substances. Only very small purses will be permitted on the bus.



Once you get on the bus you will **NOT** be permitted off for any reason. You must ride your assigned bus to and from Grad Bus. If the bus driver stops at a rest stop, **Students WILL NOT be allowed to leave the bus.**



The Broward County Code of Conduct is in effect, this includes the drug and weapon policy. If you break these rules you will not be returning on the bus and a parent will need to pick you up in Orlando.



Cigarettes are not allowed on the bus nor at the Park – leave them at home.



The following things are NOT allowed on the bus: smoking, alcoholic beverages, drugs, thermos jugs, water bottles, or containers, coolers, pillows, electronic games of any type, food, drinks, or hats of any kind. **In other words, bring yourself and maybe a sweater for the bus** (the bus gets cold on the way home)



IF YOU ARE TAKING ANY TYPE OF MEDICATION THAT IS LISTED ON YOUR PERMISSION FORM (THIS IS THE ONLY MEDICATION YOU'RE ALLOWED TO BRING), you must get a special medical form from your class sponsors and have it with you when you load the bus (otherwise, the medication will be confiscated).



There will be **NO REFUNDS, NO EXCEPTIONS.**

Dress Code Policy

***Anyone not within dress code will not be allowed to board the buses.**

GIRLS: Dresses, skirts, shorts, casual pants (including jeans), blouses and tops, comfortable shoes (including tennis shoes, dress sandals, boots and flip flops)

GUYS: Casual pants (including khakis and jeans), shorts, shirts with collars (golf/polo and dress shirts), t-shirts with sleeves and in good condition, sport jackets, dress suits, comfortable shoes (including tennis shoes, dress shoes, boots, and flip-flops)

Unacceptable Attire

Ladies:

- Halter and similar style tops
- Tops that show midriff
- Mini skirts or mini dresses

Gentlemen:

- Tank Tops
- Sleeveless Shirts
- Undershirts

For Everyone

- Any clothing affiliated with a school, professional sports team, group, club, area code, etc. (students only)
- Clothes not in good repair (ripped, torn, etc.)
- Revealing clothing (i.e. bathing suits, see-through clothing, cropped shirts that show midriffs)
- Visible undergarments
- Hats or bandanas (either worn or hanging from belt loops/pockets etc.)
- Backpacks or bags of any type, size, or style
