

Colored Pencil Sketch

For this assignment, you will be using a different graphics program, Corel Painter Essentials and a graphics tablet to create an image that looks like colored pencil sketch.

You will be creating two images; the first is a directed image, created using one of images provided. The second image will be done using the same technique, but using one of your own images.

You will be using a feature called Cloning to create your drawing.

Cloning is a feature that can help you create art, quickly and easily. Cloning is the process of taking imagery from one area or document (the source) and re-creating it in another area or document (the destination).

Cloning is a two-step process: First, you set a clone source, then you work in a destination area.

Go to your **Applications** folder and look for the folder “**Corel Painter Essentials**”.

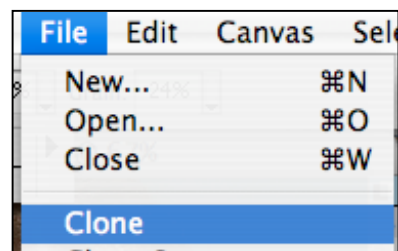


Open the folder and drag the **Painter Essentials** application to your dock.



1. Open the **Painter** program. Then go to **file>open** and open the image that you downloaded from the website.

2. When the image opens, go to **File>Clone**.



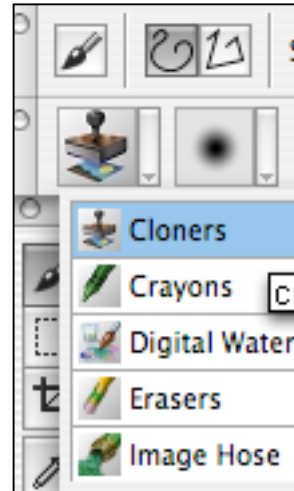
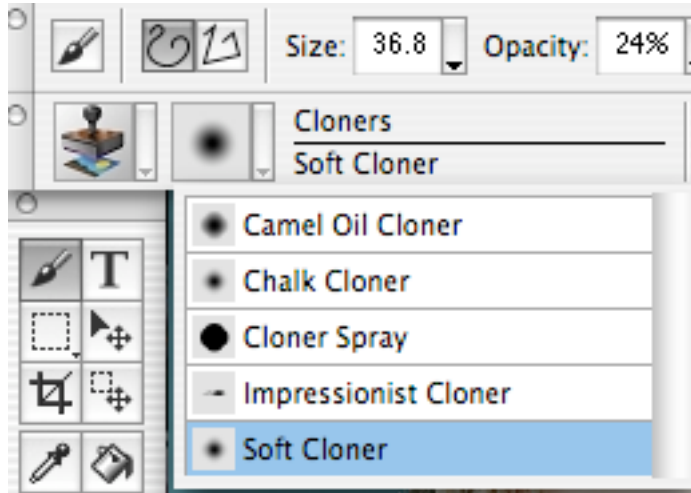
Corel Painter Essentials creates a duplicate of the original document. This is the clone. It appears in its own document window, with the words "**Clone of**" preceding the original document's name in the title bar.

Now you will paint with Cloner brushes.

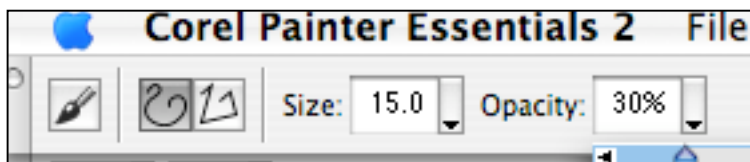
3. Working with the **clone image**, go to **menu > Select All**. Press **Delete** to clear the entire canvas.

4. Choose a **Cloner brush** from the Brush selector bar.

Choose the **soft cloner**.



On the property bar, adjust size to **15** and the opacity to **30**.



5. Paint on the blank screen, using cross-hatching strokes (lines going one way, then lines crossing those lines, going the other way.). **Strive for a “drawing look”**.

6. Continue doing this until the drawing is complete. When done, save the drawing as **Yourname.coloredpencil1** and put in the teacher drop box.

For your second image, use any of the images in your digital file cabinet. Pick something interesting.

Follow the cloning procedure and make the drawing look like a colored pencil sketch.

When done, save the drawing as **Yourname.coloredpencil2** and put in the teacher drop box.
