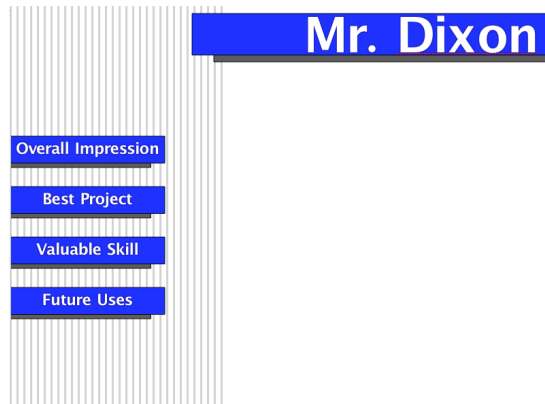
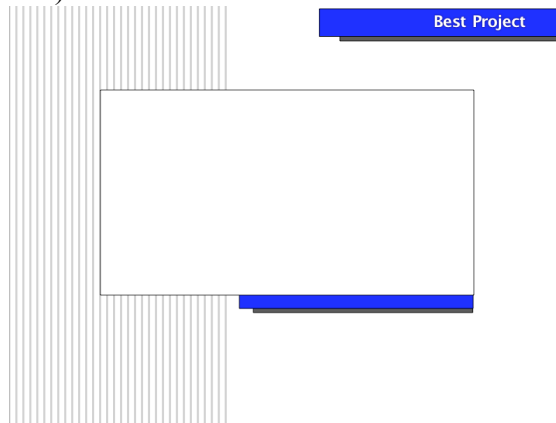


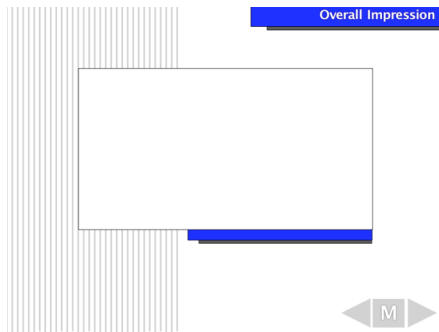
1. You will be creating a Quicktime movie that allows for user interaction.
2. Create a first screen with your name at the top.
3. Create four different text boxes labeled as follows:
  - a. Overall Impression
  - b. Valuable Skill
  - c. Best Project
  - d. Future Uses
4. Make it pretty.



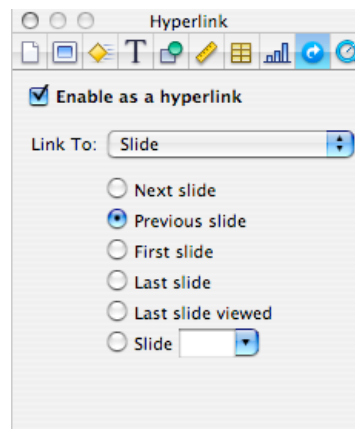
5. Using the same look as your initial slide, create four separate slides for each of your four buttons. You must add a white text box in the middle of your slide. (The easiest way to do this is to duplicate the slide and take away pieces of the slide you don't want.)



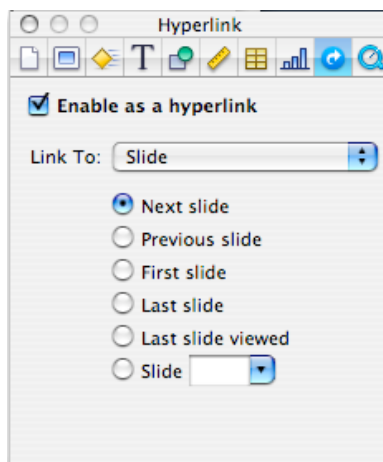
6. Now head back to slide #2. You must create three navigation buttons: a back arrow, a home button, and a forward button. Once again, make sure they match your slide design.



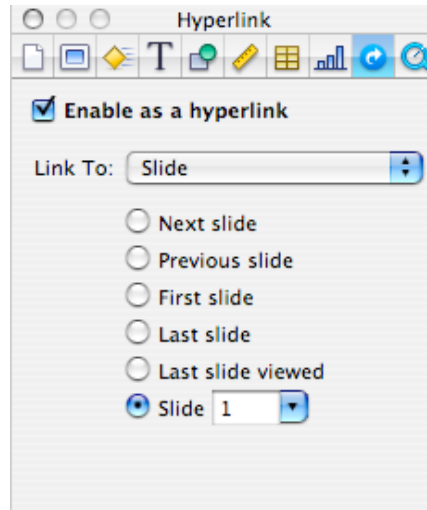
7. While on that slide, click on your left arrow button and open up inspector. Click on the blue/white arrow, check the box for "Enable as hyperlink" and choose "Previous slide."



8. While still on that slide, click on your right arrow button and open up inspector. Click on the blue/white arrow, check the box for "Enable as hyperlink" and choose "Next slide."



9. While still on that slide, click on your home button and open up inspector. Click on the blue/white arrow, check the box for “Enable as hyperlink” and choose “Slide” and choose slide 1.



10. Now select all three of those buttons and paste them onto slides 3, 4 and 5.
11. Using the same skill you just learned, go back to the first slide and make each of those four buttons link to their corresponding page. (Future uses button would connect to the future uses page...)
12. Now go back and type your responses into the text box for each slide. What was your overall impression of the class, what was your best project, what skill do you feel was most valuable, and how could you use what you've learned this year later in your life?
13. Now open up inspector, click on the white paper, and where it reads Presentation normal, choose hyperlinks only.
14. Play your slideshow and make sure all your buttons work.
15. When finished, let's get ready to export. Go to File, Export, and choose Quicktime. Chose Hyperlinks only from the playback control, choose CD-ROM size, and save as FinalKeynote\_LastNameP?"
