

1. Download the spotlight examples from my website. These are from Keynote Theme Park. Great company.
2. You are now going to do some researching and playing.
3. First, go through their keynote and get their info. You'll need it.
4. When you're done with that, open a new Keynote project and save it as Keynote2_lastnameP?". You should have two Keynote projects open, yours and theirs.
5. Make your background black.
6. Copy a spotlight and light from the Spotlight Keynote for use on your own project.
7. Play with the resizing, rotating and opacity. Ungroup it, see what parts are where, regroup. Play with the pivot.
8. I want you to now create 5 different slides using three spotlights. You will have slide #1 that's all dark with the lights off, slide #2 with one light coming on, slide #3 with that light going off and another coming on, slide #4 with that light on and another coming on, and slide #5 with all lights going off.
9. This should be a smooth looking presentation.
10. Using that same idea, I want you to mask three pictures into three circles. Add some shadows and effects to make them fit into those five slides you just created. Think of the China ball example they showed you. I want that. You will have to use gradients, some shadows, and some light effects.
11. Go to File – Export – Quicktime – Self Playing movie – Web movie small – include transparency.
