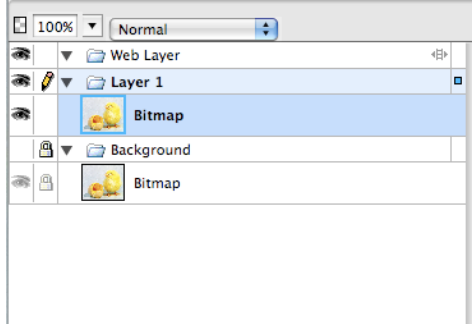
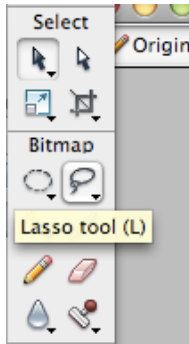


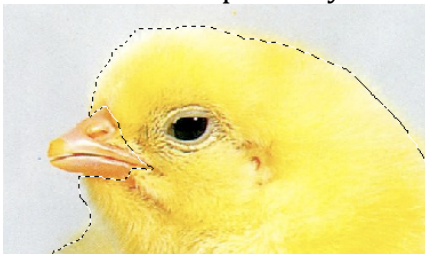
1. Control + click on the chicken file and open with Fireworks.
2. Copy and paste the layer and drag one copy into the Layer 1 folder. Lock the Background copy and turn off the eyeball.



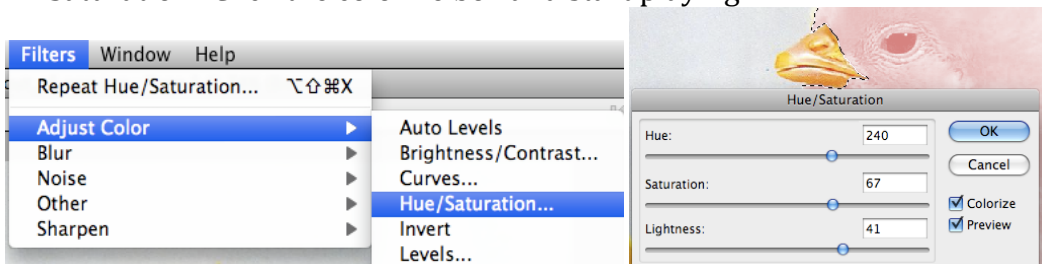
3. Save as "tutorial6_lastname_p?".
4. Choose the lasso tool and change the properties window to read edge = Feather and size of 3.



5. Using the lasso tool, carefully go around the outside of the chicken. Like the pen tool, your last point must be the same as the first point. Be careful, you must do this perfectly or else you must start over.



6. If you do mess up, just close off the lasso, and go up to Select – Deselect.
7. With your chick still outlined, go up to Filters – Adjust Color – Hue and Saturation. Click the colorize box and start playing.



8. Once you're happy with the color, go up to Select – Deselect and see what your chick looks like. If you're happy with the results, save it.
9. Now we need to fix the eye. Lock and turn off the eye for Layer 1 and turn the eye back on for Background Copy and unlock it.
10. Use the lasso tool to carefully go around the black part of the eye on the original chick.
11. Edit – copy.
12. Relock and turn the eye off on that layer and go back to the layer you're changing the color on. Unlock it and turn the eye back on.
13. Choose that layer and hit Shift+apple+V.
14. Notice how the eye goes into the exact spot on the chick.
15. Add group members' names.
16. Save it and dropbox it.

1. For Tutorial #7 you're going to play with the banana picture. Change each banana to a different color. You'll be using the same technique as you did with the chick.
2. Be sure to copy the dark tip part on the banana to maintain a "real picture" on each one.
3. Add names.
4. When done and happy with it, dropbox it as "tutorial7_lastname_p?"
