

In order to show growth and understanding of concepts presented in class, you will be required to complete a research paper. The topic will be on a major figure in the field of psychology. You will explore the figure's perspectives on the field of psychology, their research and any experiments, and their lasting impact. The paper will be required to be twelve to fifteen pages in length. It must be double-spaced and in no more than 12 point Times New Roman font. Students must use APA style of formatting. Borders in excess of one inch will not be accepted. All papers will be turned in by using turnitin.com and must show a level of understanding worthy of college level work. In addition, you will turn in a hard copy of your paper. Your topic must be approved prior to starting your project. Topics are due by 9/30/2009. If you are not in class that day, you may email me the topic. Plagiarism will not be tolerated.

Below is a link listing the 100 most eminent psychologists of the 20th century. You may choose someone off of this list or any other individual. Your paper is due 11/12/09 and it is worth a two test grades. There are no exceptions on this date. It must be received by turnitin.com by 11:59 PM. If you are not in class that day you must have a hard copy of your paper delivered to the front office by 3:00 PM. Your title page and bibliography do not count in your page count. You must have at least six resources for your project. Only two resources may be web based. You may not use Wikipedia. Your web-based resources must be educational based.
