

AP Psychology Testing Project

This project will allow you to develop an understanding of the role of testing and the use of assessment instruments in the field of psychology. In this project, you will administer several different testing instruments ranging from inventories to projective tests. You will work with a partner where you will administer and take the tests. After the tests are completed, you will score the tests and write a summary report.

The point of this project is not to find out information; it is to see how instruments are used in the field of psychology. You will take turns in the assessing process. While being interviewed, you will present as a person seeking psychological services.

The grading on this project will be in two parts. You will receive one grade for the testing piece and one grade for write an evaluation report.

For the testing piece the grading will be as follows:

- 1) 25% Constructive use of class time
- 2) 25% Administering tests
- 3) 25% Scoring tests

For the report the grading will be as follows:

- 1) 25% Intake interview summary
- 2) 25% Testing summary and explanation

This project is worth 125 points. You will be given time in class to work on this project, but the final summary will need to be completed outside of class.
