

## Dual-Enrollment Movie Project

In studying Psychology movies are often referred to illustrate theories, concepts, and ideas. They can provide a backdrop or canvas that allows the student to have a visual depiction to enhance their learning. The purpose of this project is to allow you the opportunity to look more in depth into an area of Psychology that you are most interested in learning about. You will select a movie from the list provided or have a movie that you are interested in approved prior to starting the project. You will view the movie and complete a paper based on what you have seen in the movie. The following areas need to be covered in your paper:

- 1) What was your reasoning for selecting the topic movie that you picked?
- 2) What is the topic/topics that apply to psychology that were covered in the movie? Ex: "A Beautiful Mind" – Topics: Schizophrenia, Treatment of disorders & Family dynamics in dealing with mental illness.
- 3) How has what you studied/researched been helped by seeing this movie?
- 4) What was your understanding of your topic before viewing your movie and has your view changed since seeing your movie?

You will need to provide a detailed review of the movie. In your review you will provide examples of the disorders noted and describe how they played out in the movie. This is an opportunity for you to expand your learning through nontraditional means. This should be seen as a serious project and will be graded as such.

Your paper is due on 11/25/09. It must be written in 12 pt font Times New Roman. It must be spaced at 1.5 and a minimum of 5 full pages and no more than 7 pages.
