

Citing an Online Image

Very important! If you are citing an image found in Google Images or any other image retrieval service, be certain to cite the image in its original context. Do not provide the URL of the enlarged image - you must use the URL of the page where the image was originally shown.

Image creator's last name, first name, if available, or page author's name if available, followed by a period and a space

Title of photo followed by a period, in quotation marks. If no title,

describe briefly within quotation marks.

Descriptive word (photo, map, cartoon, drawing, etc,) followed

by a period and a space

Website title in italics, followed by a space

Website publication date in DD Mo. YYYY format followed by a

period and a space

Date image was viewed in DD Mo. YYYY format followed by a

space

Web address in angle brackets, followed by a period

***example:* Suzuki, Lea. "Mick Jaggar." Photo. *SFGate.com* 14 Nov.**
