

# Character Poster

Create a poster for a character in a story using at least 5 the Summary of Visual Images Chart. The poster must have a caption to go with it.

Explain in writing on a separate paper the visual choices you made based on using at least 5 of the items on the Summary of Visual Images Chart.

Example: Let's say you made a poster such as the picture below. Here is how you would explain some of your choices:



Caption: Neo is the only one who can save the world.

Technique	Explanation
<b>Proportion</b>	I made Neo the only figure on the page to show that he is the only person who can save the world from the <i>Matrix</i> .
<b>Color</b>	I made Neo dressed in black to show that he is a dark kind of character, he is mysterious and likes to hide from the light where the agents might see him.
<b>Lighting</b>	The lighting is from below and the sides, because the shadows make the character look scarier.
<b>Shape</b>	The shape of the glasses are frames for some of the important scenes in the movie.
<b>Font and Size</b>	The font is plain to look modern and is small so it does not take attention away from Neo.

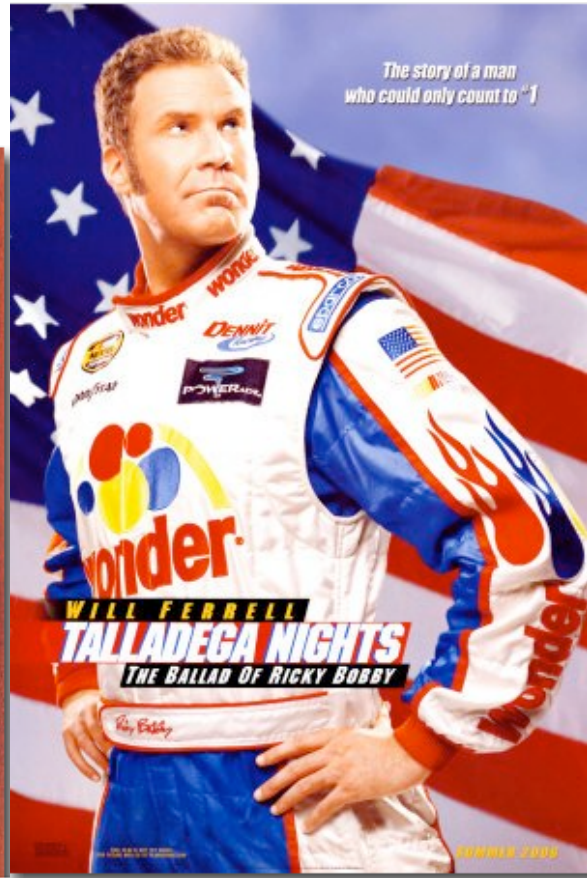
