Course Content:

Algebra 1B is a course designed to develop the algebraic concepts and processes that can be used to solve a variety of real world and mathematical problems. The content shall include structure & properties of the real number system, including rational & irrational numbers; algebraic notation including exponents, square roots, radicals, absolute value, and scientific notation; varied means for analyzing & expressing patterns, relations, and functions including words, tables graphs, sequences, linear & quadratic equations, and inequalities; polynomials & operations with polynomials; coordinate geometry and graphing of linear & quadratic functions and inequalities; data analysis concepts and techniques including introductory statistics and probability; and varied solution strategies for linear and quadratic equations and for systems of equations.

Classroom Expectations: Everyone has the ability to learn; when you enter the classroom it is expected you will be ready to do so. Students are expected to participate, practice, and learn. Proper behavior and a polite attitude are also required. Be positive, do your very best, and ask me for help when needed.

Students are expected to comply with the following:

- * **BE PREPARED & PARTICIPATE-** Have your materials and homework daily & wear your ID badge. Be on time, ready to work and active in your learning.
- * **LISTEN CAREFULLY, WORK QUIETLY & DO NOT BE DISRUPTIVE**
- * **FOLLOW DIRECTIONS & ALL SCHOOL RULES-** Listen to spoken and read written directions. **NO ARGUING!**
- * **RESPECT-** Me and my personal property, your peers, & this classroom.

Sleeping or putting heads on desks are not allowed. You will be asked to stand if you repeatedly do so. If you are not feeling well during class, please see me. Rule violations will result in removal from the classroom, student conferences, detentions, parent involvement, and administrative referrals (IS/ES).

Pass Policy: Students will receive five out-of-class passes per quarter. Unused passes may be turned in at the end of the quarter for points added to your participation grade. **DO NOT** lose them as you will not be issued additional passes.

Suggested Class Materials:

In order to be successful in class you should bring the following to class everyday:
